Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Faith,

Happy New Year! The first weekend in December we begin a brand new Church Year as we enter the season of Advent. Historically, Advent covers the four weeks prior to Christmas, and we "count down the weeks" until Jesus' birth with the visible sign of an Advent Wreath, lighting an additional candle each week. This year, the fourth weekend of Advent collides with Christmas Eve, so we will have a spectacular series of celebrations on December 23rd and 24th, as we do our final preparations — and also celebrate Christmas Eve, back to back. Check out the schedules to the right for specific times!

This year, we will feature a sermon and study series each week during Advent that we are calling, "Making Sense of Christ's Birth"! As we prepare to receive Christ born into our world, we recognize that it is through our senses that God meets us. The first week of Advent we will focus on the sense of sight — how what we see informs our experience of God coming into our world. Thank you to Linda Haack for creating our new Advent Banner that you will see at the altar beginning the first week of Advent! Our vision is enhanced and focused that first week of Advent as we collect all the sights and visions that accompany Jesus' birth.

What other senses are engaged at the Incarnation of our God? Be sure to join us each week to discover and engage your own sensory acuity! Prior to worship on Saturday afternoons, at 4:30pm, and on Sunday mornings at 10am, we will have special activities and conversations about the "sense" of the week for participants of ALL AGES!

Our journey toward "Making Sense of Christ's Birth" will culminate in our Christmas Eve worship on December 24th, where all of our senses will be engaged as we welcome the Newborn Savior of the World with beautiful song and special music, the warmth of gathering at the Table, and the glow of candlelight reflecting in our countenances the Peace of Jesus.

Dear TLC friends,

Now is a great time to connect with S.T.R.E.A.M., Manatee county's social justice organization. You can attend the Annual Assembly at 6:30pm, Monday Dec. 4 at St. Mary's Episcopal Church in Palmetto.

Last year we made solid progress on the two issues we tackled:

increasing affordable housing and creating alternatives to being arrested for adults who commit minor, nonviolent offenses.

At the December 4 event, we'll choose the new issue(s) STREAM will immediately start working on. Each congregation will get as many votes as they have members present at this meeting. It's a nice opportunity to see for yourself how the process works. That's a good reason to go, but here are four more reasons!

- 1. It's God's work. When you support STREAM, you're answering the Lord's call to do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with your God. (Micah 6:8).
- 2. It's local. STREAM addresses important issues that affect people we know and care about right here in our neighborhoods.
- 3. It's connection. A number of folks in your Trinity family are already active in STREAM. What could be more fun than hanging out with them, as well as getting to know some additional folks in the other local congregations that have joined STREAM? We're doing this together, in community.
- 4. It's easy. Just attend the assembly at St. Mary's, 1010 24th Ave W in Palmetto. Need a ride? Let me know! Want to carpool? Meet at Trinity and be ready to roll out by 6:05pm on Monday, December 4.

As a bonus, if you attend you can also vote for the Executive Committee officers for the next year... including me! I've been nominated to serve as the Treasurer.

As Jamerson gets ready to turn three years old, he is doing well in each of the child development categories except communication. We await some testing that can occur once he turns three, and then will have some additional options for seeking developmental speech training for him.

Julliana continues to be grateful for

all the love and support with which her Trinity Family surrounds her. She confesses that she does not know what she would do without us. As the months add up to years, we join Julliana in confessing that we don't know what our lives would be like without her and Jamerson, and thanking God for sending her to us in November of 2020. Julliana's road toward asylum is lengthy and challenging. We are grateful God has called us to accompany her!



Chef Darrell's Lump Crab & Cavatappi Pasta Salad

Yields 8 servings

Ingredients:

- 2 lb cooked Cavatappi noodles (follow package directions) & chill approximately 1 hour
- 1 8oz can Backfin Lump Crab
- 1 C diced celery 1 T granulated sugar
- 1/2 C zucchini seeded and diced
- 1/2 C yellow squash seeded and diced
- 1/2 C red onion diced 1/2 C red bell pepper - diced
- 1 C shredded mozzarella 2 C poppyseed dressing
- 1 C basil julienned

Salt, pepper, granulated garlic to taste

Directions:

- In a large bowl, combine all ingredients except dressing, seasoning and basil.
- Use rubber spatula; fold everything together.
- Add seasonings, then incorporate dressing.
- Keep refrigerated until ready to serve. Serve with garlic bread.

served! We learned some tips about seeding and dicing, too!
