

# NCECA TOUR AND SHUTTLE INFORMATION

Welcome to the information describing the NCECA **Tours** and **Shuttle Routes** offered by Avion Tours (formerly Lew White Tours—same people, new name) during the 2023 Conference in Cincinnati.

Here's a summary of the tours and shuttle routes available at the 2023 Conference in Cincinnati:

- Wednesday All-Day **Tour** to exhibitions in the Camp Washington/Northside area of Cincinnati. This tour includes stops to visit the **2023 NCECA Multicultural Fellowship Exhibition and the 2023 NCECA Juried Student Exhibition.**
- Wednesday All-Day **"Taste of Cincinnati" Tour** visiting select exhibitions in the Cincinnati area including the **2023 NCECA Multicultural Fellowship Exhibition, the 2023 NCECA Juried Student Exhibition and the 2023 NCECA Annual.**
- Wednesday Afternoon **Tour** visiting 15 exhibitions at seven venues in the Norwood/Walnut Hills area of Cincinnati.
- Thursday Night **Northeast Reception Tour** to 13 exhibitions at five venues on the northeast side of Cincinnati.
- Thursday Night **Northwest Reception Tour** to 11 exhibitions, including the **2023 NCECA Multicultural Fellowship Exhibition and the 2023 NCECA Juried Student Exhibition,** at seven venues on the northwest side of Cincinnati.
- Friday Night **Reception Shuttle** to nine venues featuring 23 exhibitions including the **2023 NCECA Annual.**

Detailed information about these opportunities are on the following pages. But, before continuing, here are two definitions:

**Tours (Wednesday and Thursday)** - Everyone boards the bus on the Elm Street side of the Duke Energy Convention Center at the same time and stays together during the entire tour. At each stop a certain amount of time is allowed to visit the exhibition(s). At the end of each visit everyone re-boards the bus and travels to the next stop where the scenario is repeated.

**Shuttle (Friday)** - Buses operate continuously (much like a city bus system) with departures approximately every 20-25 minutes (depending on the shuttle route) from the Elm Street side of the Duke Energy Convention Center. Board the bus at the Duke Energy Convention Center at your leisure. Each rider receives a wristband which is the "ticket" to re-board the bus at any stop along the route. Riders may **HOP-OFF** at any of the stops on the shuttle route and visit the exhibition(s) knowing that every 20-25 minutes a bus will be available at the shuttle stop to **HOP-ON** and ride to the next exhibition the rider wants to visit or return to the Duke Energy Convention Center. The shuttle ticket allows the rider to **HOP-OFF** and **HOP-ON** at any or all stops on the shuttle route. NOTE: A separate and unique shuttle ticket is needed for each shuttle route.

The following pages describe the **Tours** and **Shuttle Route** offered Wednesday through Friday. Included with each description is the tour itinerary or shuttle stop number, the venue(s) at each stop and the exhibition(s) at each venue. ( For more detailed information about the exhibition(s) at each stop please go to the "Exhibition" section on the NCECA Conference website.)

- Tickets for the **Tours** and **Shuttle Route** can be ordered in advance on-line and by mail, telephone or email. To order tickets via:
- On-Line Access the NCECA Conference website and "click" on the link to the Avion Tours and Travel website and complete the on-line order form.

A receipt for all advance ticket orders will be sent to the email address provided. Tickets purchased in advance will be available for pick-up at the "Tour and Shuttle Booth" at the Convention Center starting at 12:00n on Tuesday, March 14<sup>th</sup>.

Separate tickets must be purchased for each **Tour** and **Shuttle Route**. Each **Tour** and **Shuttle Route** has two prices listed. The lower price is when tickets are purchased on or before Wednesday, March 8, 2023 and the higher price is when tickets are purchased on March 9<sup>th</sup> or later. The last day to order advance tickets and receive the lower ticket price is Wednesday, March 8, 2023 at 5:00pmET.

Routes have been planned to maximize and facilitate riders' access to exhibitions surrounding the Conference. Please be aware some routes include stops at exhibitions within walking distance of the Cincinnati Convention Center. All ticket sales are final; there are no refunds or exchanges.

All tickets purchased in advance **MUST** be picked up at the "Tour and Shuttle Booth" in the Convention Center. **We are unable to "read" confirmations on mobile devices at the bus loading location.**
