Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Faith,

Christ is Risen!

He is Risen indeed — Alleluia!

While our Season of Lent and celebration of the Resurrection of Christ held a ton of meaningful faith expressions — from the beautiful Taize Prayer and fellowship around table, the deeply moving Tenebrae service where the Choir shared *The Dark Hours*, and the joyous sounds and sights of Easter, nothing stirred my heart more deeply than being part of the Sacrament of Holy Baptism for four of our young people at Trinity. Eric Glushonkov (11 years old) and Allan Glushonkov (9 years old) and Karmen and Karissa Williams (both 10 years old) gathered with their families around the Baptismal Font on Easter Eve — a traditional time for the celebration of Holy Baptism — and were welcomed into this community of faith and the cosmic Body of Christ. They “renounced” the devil and all the forces that defy God and they proclaimed their faith in God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

For Karmen, Karissa, Eric and Allan, the journey to the Font has been a lengthy one. Eric and Allan have both been brought to Trinity from the time of their birth — sons of our amazing Saturday night keyboardist, Sergei. Karissa and Karmen also have been participants in our community since they were 2 and 1/2 years old. We have talked about Baptism in the past — and then earlier this year, Pastor Kerri began an intentional time of teaching about Baptism with these young people during our Saturday evening J.O.Y. (Intergenerational Faith Formation) times. If you attended (or watched) Saturday night worship, you will remember the J.O.Y. moments where the young people shared with us their discoveries about God’s grace and forgiveness, and God’s

desire to strengthen our aversion to evil. Developing a working understanding of what it means to “renounce” the powers and forces that work against God’s precious kingdom is a huge learning — and Pastor Kerri did an awesome job of walking with these young people — along with her assistant instructor Jaden Jimenez!

As you will remember, a primary reason for calling Pastor Kerri as our Associate Pastor last July was for this very purpose — to enable us to help our young people fall in love with Jesus and find a meaningful expression in the life of the church. I am grateful for Pastor Kerri’s work with these particular young people, and the multiple additional efforts we now have in place to link young people together with faith veterans and pass on this amazing spiritual trust we have been given.

If you are willing to help further this important movement in our faith community, we have several places that you can serve: 1) participants in the Growing Young Team are being sought, to help plan and execute particular events that connect people of all ages; 2) Barbara Michaelsen is heading our Sunday morning Faith Formation for children and needs a couple of adults to come and forge relationships with these young people as we model faith and share the stories of our faith; 3) our Kids Night Out events could use some additional adult helpers; 4) VBS Day Camp is just around the corner — see Pastor Kerri’s article in this Trends about ways to participate!

Christ is Risen, and we are Easter People Indeed! May the love and joy of Christ’s arising not be something you simply harbor in your own soul, but the compelling reason you share your faith across generations together!

Dear Friends,

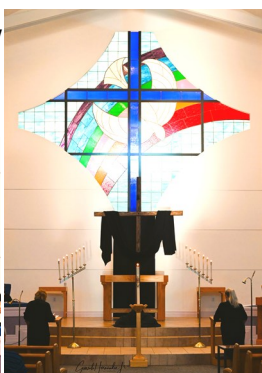
Julliana and Jamerson Up-Date

Judi Stephens shared her Garlic Shrimp Soup recipe:

1 Sausage Roll (Jimmy Dean's Regular or similar)

2 celery stalks, small diced

1 medium onion, small diced

2 medium potatoes, baked (optional)

1/3 Cup Garlic, fine chopped (yes, really)

2 pounds of chopped shrimp, large chop

1 Tbsp. Slightly heaping ChefPaul Prudhomme Seafood Magic (you can use Old Bay in a pinch)

1 Quart Half and Half

3 cups of milk

1 package of Sausage flavored gravy mix (you can use a thickening agent like flour or cornstarch, but why not add more flavor?!)

1/2 cup Parmesan Cheese Shaved or Grated (I get mine from the cheese coolers - not the Kraft)

Cook sausage, onions and celery together. Spoon out as much grease as possible. Add garlic, continue cooking for a couple minutes. Add chopped shrimp and seafood seasoning, continue cooking while stirring until shrimp is pink. Add peeled, chopped baked potatoes, Half and Half, Milk, and sausage flavored gravy mix (or thickening agent) and continue to stir on medium. Once it has cooked a while for flavors to distribute, add parmesan cheese and continue stirring. Pepper (if wanted) to taste. Enjoy!

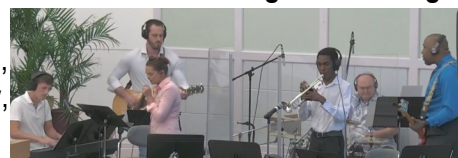

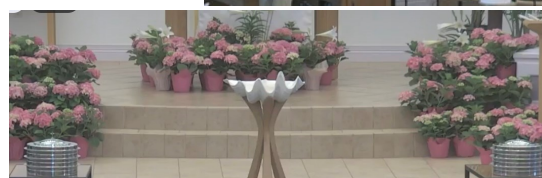
Sunday Sunrise worship concludes as birds begin to chirp and the sun begins to rise. The indoor worship at 8am featured organ and trumpet!

Dinner and a Concert

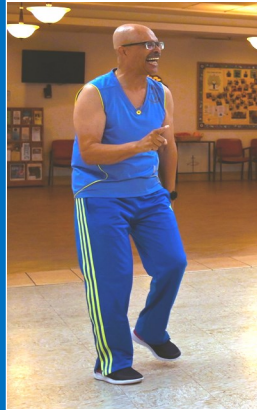


We gathered for an amazing dinner before the concert April 12th. Then Edgar and Lori Bower held us spell-bound with their piano and organ solos, two-

Gonzalo is BACK! We remembered — or just joyfully moved — to the Zumba tunes of past years! Happily, Gonzalo is willing to Zumba more!

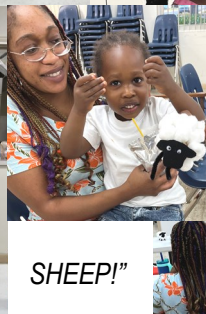

Team Trivia



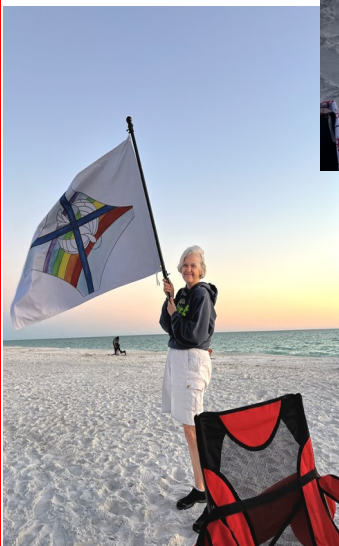

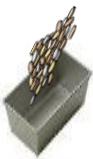
